

Regular paper may be divided in a number of sections. Section titles (including references and acknowledgement) should be typed using 11 pt fonts with **bold** option. For numbering use Times New Roman number. Sections can be split in subsection, which should be typed 10 pt *Italic* option. Figures should be one column wide. If it is impossible to place figure in one column, two column wide figures is allowed. Each figure must have a caption under the figure. For the figure captions 10 pt font should be used. (1)

3. Illustrations, images and tables

Figures, images and tables should be numbered consecutively according to the order in which they are cited in the text. Any illustration, image or table must be titled as shown below. The publisher reserves the right to reject any figure that does not meet the necessary quality standards for publication. Preferable the pictures format is TIF, quality 300 DPI. Do not send illustration in PowerPoint presentation files, convert them to JPG, TIFF or EPS.
